

## 2014 Tropical Cyclone Fatalities

Fortunately, the United States was again spared any major land falling tropical storms. There were no U.S. tropical storm related deaths in 2014. Despite the low fatality rate, there were 9 named tropical storms in the Atlantic Basin in 2014, of which 6 had wind speeds measuring hurricane force. Most of these storms died in the Atlantic Ocean. The Pacific Basin was more active with 21 named storms: 15 of which were designated hurricanes.
