

2010 Tornado Fatalities

Tornadoes caused 45 deaths in the United States in 2010, more than double the previous year, which numbered 21 victims, but below the 10-year average of 56. As in most years, the most dangerous identified place to be during a tornado was in a mobile home, which accounted for 19 (42%) of deaths. Permanent homes were the next most fatal location with 11 (24%) of fatalities, trailed by 7 victims (16%) killed while outdoors. Once again, tornado fatalities are one of few weather events where more females are victims than males: 25 (56%) women and 20 (44%) men, possibly because this category is only one more heavily affecting persons in a home than outside. Victims spanned the age ranges, but were most heavily impacted in the 50-79 year old categories with 24 deaths (53%).
