515 AM PST WED DEC 4 2013

...MINOR TIDAL OVERFLOW POSSIBLE DURING THE MID-MORNING HOURS...

.A STRONG COLD FRONT MOVING THROUGH THE AREA WILL CREATE ELEVATED SURF AND GUSTY WINDS TODAY. THIS...COMBINED WITH ASTRONOMICAL HIGH TIDES EXCEEDING 7 FEET THIS MORNING...WILL CREATE THE POSSIBILITY OF MINOR TIDAL OVERFLOW OF LOW-LYING AREAS ALONG THE BEACH. HIGH TIDES WILL LOWER BELOW 7 FEET STARTING THURSDAY.

...BEACH HAZARDS STATEMENT REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL NOON PST TODAY...

* SURF...3 TO 5 FEET...WITH HIGHEST SURF ON WEST FACING BEACHES.

* HIGH TIDE...7.3 FEET AT 915 AM IN SAN DIEGO...AND 6.8 FEET AT 912 AM IN NEWPORT BEACH.

* TIMING...AROUND MID-MORNING TODAY.

* IMPACTS...MINOR FLOODING OF LOW-LYING AREAS ALONG THE BEACH...INCLUDING BEACH PARKING LOTS.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A BEACH HAZARDS STATEMENT FOR MINOR TIDAL OVERFLOW MEANS THAT HIGH ASTRONOMICAL TIDES...POSSIBLY IN COMBINATION WITH ABOVE NORMAL SURF...MAY PRODUCE MINOR FLOODING OF LOW-LYING AREAS ALONG THE BEACH...SUCH AS BEACH PARKING LOTS. COASTAL OFFICIALS SHOULD TAKE THE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO SAFEGUARD THEIR BEACHES.
