

SCOUR VOICE FILES ON LDAD

All the VIP Remote (S)FTP users must convert to a standard configuration supported by CRS. Sites must dump the VIP messages (.wav or .mp3 files) to the LDAD Server (LS1), and then either push them out to the external system or have the external system retrieve them from LS1. Sites should use the **scour** script to limit the number of days of voice files that will be kept on LS1.

The following file should be modified to purge old .wav and/or .mp3 files on LS1:

/ldad/data/scour.conf.ls

To do this, you add an entry that contains the voice files' **directory name** and the **number of days they are to be kept**.

For example, to keep three days of voice files, add the following entry:

/data/Incoming/voice 3 *

IMPORTANT NOTE: Sites should backup the modified scour script in case it is overwritten during future software installations.
