

VIP Logs Are Not Being Cleaned Out Every Month

The maintenance and runtime VIP logs are only removed when a new disk image is restored. Over time, these log files can start filling up the hard drive. They need to be cleaned out to keep the hard drive clean. The current VIP version 3.2 software added a new VIPCleanLog script, which runs at 03:30 am on the 2nd day of every month to clean out these log files and keep only the last month's worth. However, the entry for this script in the /etc/crontab file is incorrect:

***Incorrect Entry:* 30 3 2 * * root /usr/local/bin/CleanLog**

***Correct Entry:* 30 3 2 * * root /usr/local/bin/VIPCleanLog**

As root user, please modify your /etc/crontab file to make this change, so your VIP runtime and maintenance logs will be cleaned out on the 2nd day of every month at 03:30 am. Future builds (starting with VIP Build 3.2.2) will guarantee that the /etc/crontab entry is correct.
