

## 2015 Tropical Cyclone Fatalities

Although hurricanes and tropical storms claimed no lives in the mainland of the United States, the U.S. territory of Guam numbered 14 deaths. There were 12 named tropical storms in the Atlantic Basin in 2014, of which 3 had wind speeds measuring hurricane force. Most of these storms died in the Atlantic Ocean. The Pacific Basin was more active with 22 named storms, 13 of which were designated hurricanes.
