

## 2010 Winter Weather Fatalities

There were 21 winter storm deaths in 2010, down from 28 in 2009. This number is just below the 10-year average of 23. North Carolina recorded the highest death toll with 3, followed by Alabama, Delaware, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, Tennessee, and Wisconsin with 2 each. The most hazardous place to be in the winter of 2010 was outside, 11, (52%) followed by in a vehicle, 7 (33%). In a switch from previous years, the highest category of victims was not the 20-29 year age ranges, but rather 30-39, 40-49 and 50-59 age ranges, which each numbered 4 deaths (19%). More males, 15 (71%) than females, 6 (29%) died in winter storms.
