

## Changes to Wording in the WFO TCV (Amended SCN 14-67)

- To better communicate the threat, the following changes (highlighted in **red**) to the threat sections for each of the **segments/hazards** was made:

### During Watch and Warning Phases Prior to Onset

([TCV\\_case1Full.txt](#), [TCV\\_case2Full.txt](#) examples):

#### \* WIND

- LATEST LOCAL FORECAST: EQUIVALENT STRONG TROPICAL STORM FORCE WIND
  - PEAK WIND FORECAST: 45-60 MPH WITH GUSTS TO 80 MPH
  - WINDOW FOR TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS: EARLY MONDAY MORNING UNTIL MONDAY AFTERNOON
- **CURRENT** THREAT TO LIFE AND PROPERTY: HIGH
  - BULLETS
- POTENTIAL IMPACTS: EXTENSIVE
  - BULLETS

**Note:** the same change in red also applies to the STORM SURGE, FLOODING RAIN, and TORNADO threats

### Once conditions are ongoing:

#### \* WIND

- LATEST LOCAL FORECAST: EQUIVALENT STRONG TROPICAL STORM FORCE WIND
  - PEAK WIND FORECAST: 45-60 MPH WITH GUSTS TO 80 MPH
  - WINDOW FOR TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS: EARLY MONDAY MORNING UNTIL MONDAY AFTERNOON
- **CURRENT** THREAT TO LIFE AND PROPERTY: HIGH
  - BULLETS
- POTENTIAL IMPACTS: **STILL UNFOLDING**
  - BULLETS
