The NCLADT with support from the CIO's office, has set up a Wiki for themselves and everyone else to share information and code for the local application migration. Since many local applications are built on similar needs (accessing grids, retrieving data from a DB, displaying a time series), all the developers in all the local offices will have a lot to share and learn from one another. The Wiki should facilitate this communication. You can post questions, and NCLADT members and HQ staff who have been working with the system will help find answers. When you have written a useful bit of code that others could use, you can post it there. The NCLADT will be using the Wiki as a repository for the code they develop, so others can look there first when they start coding. Everyone still has to migrate their own local apps, but by exchanging solid technical information, we may be able to simplify the migration.
