In preparation for the upcoming AWIPS Migration to a Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) (aka AWIPS II) the Office of Climate Water Weather Services (OCWWS), Training Division (TD), headed by Leroy Spayd, is planning an AWIPS SOA Migration Curriculum as part of the AWIPS II initiative. Late last year, SEC informed everyone, via the 12/19/08 Weekly Topic forum, on the revamping of the AWIPS Migration Training modules that were offered on the Commerce Learning Center (CLC) website. The TD Staff has made significant progress; the following is a brief status on some of their effort from the AWIPS Training Lead, Michael Szkil:
