They have been hosting the Raytheon AWIPS II developers at their office since January 2006, with 2 to 4 Raytheon developers visiting the WFO every month on average. The Omaha staff has also been visiting the Raytheon programmers in their office and evaluating AWIPS II in the Raytheon test lab.
