

AWIPS II Topic of the Week -- Local Application Inventory

All,

As part of the continued local applications migration from AWIPS I to AWIPS II activities, the Site Migration and the National Core Local Application Development Team (NCLADT) teams are in the process of developing a Local Application Inventory. For this inventory, the term “local application” encompasses three categories of site-added functionality:

- ❖ stand-alone and integrated applications;
- ❖ GFE additions, tools, procedures and utilities;
- ❖ Customization, including supplemental data and visualization

This inventory process is multi-phased and uses both the current Local Application Database (LAD) and Smart Tool Repository (STR). In preparation for the upcoming NCLADT Workshop, November 3-5, 2009 in Kansas City, the field developers will complete the local application inventory to be used as an AWIPS I baseline. Special thanks to the AWIPS Site Migration Lead Ashley Kells (OST/SEC) and NCLADT Lead John Olsen (OST/SEC) for their contributions. We're excited about the various migration activities and we look forward to the continued collaborations from the field.
